1 **RIGHT TO OBJECT**

2 A party, or the person served with a subpoena who objects to the subpoena, or any portion of it, may  
3 file an objection with the administrative law judge. The objection shall be filed within five (5) days  
4 after service of the subpoena, or at the outset of the hearing if the subpoena is served fewer than five  
5 (5) days before the hearing.

6 The administrative law judge shall quash or modify the subpoena if:

- 7 1. It is unreasonable or oppressive, or
- 8 2. The desired testimony or evidence may be obtained by an alternative method.
