CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 7

ORDER REGARDING MEDIA ACCESS

10 On January 30, 2014, Yvonne Wingett Sanchez of The Arizona Republic filed a
11 request to operate still and video cameras during the hearing in the above captioned
12 matter and to "live-tweet" and blog regarding the hearing from the hearing room, a copy
13 of which is attached to this Order.

14 On February 3, 2014, Jeremy Duda of The Arizona Capitol Times filed a request
15 to have a photographer present during the hearing and to use a "small digital recording
16 device" and laptop computer for the purposes of taking notes and providing online
17 updates, a copy of which is attached to this Order.

18 While reporters may be present in the hearing room, no video or audio recording
19 of the hearing will be permitted. Still camera coverage, "live-tweeting", and blogging of
20 the hearing will be allowed subject to the conditions set forth below.

21 **IT IS ORDERED** that the request to place and operate a video camera and a
22 small digital recording device is denied.¹

23 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that still camera coverage is allowed subject to the
24 following conditions:

- 25 1. Only one still camera, mounted on a tripod, with a single camera operator,
26 will be permitted in the hearing room while the hearing is in progress. The
27 Arizona Republic and The Arizona Capitol Times shall make appropriate
28 arrangements for coverage of the hearing with only one still camera each
29 day, though more than one reporter may attend the hearing. The Arizona

1 Republic and The Arizona Capitol Times agree that they will share or pool
2 their coverage with any other media that requests access.

- 4 2. The Administrative Law Judge will decide where the camera will be placed
5 in the hearing room.
- 6 3. No interviews shall be conducted in any part of the hearing room.
- 7 4. All camera equipment must be disabled and secured when FBI Agent
8 Brian Grehoski is testifying to ensure compliance with Case Management
9 Order No. 5.²
- 10 5. No auxiliary lighting, including flash bulbs, strobe lights, or reflectors, may
11 be brought into the hearing room.
- 12 6. The photographer and the camera equipment must be ready to operate
13 when the hearing is convened.
- 14 7. Equipment may only be set up, moved, or removed while the hearing is
15 not in session. The photographer may not move about the hearing room
16 while the hearing is in session.
- 17 8. The use of equipment shall not be disruptive to the hearing process or
18 cause a distraction.

19 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that "live-tweeting" and blogging is allowed so long
20 as the activity is not disruptive to the hearing process and does not cause a distraction.
